



GUIDED TOURS: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ITER's guided tours offer visitors the opportunity to see practical examples of how renewable energy is used. The guide will accompany you during your visit to provide information about the educational exhibits and the installations here and to guide you around the Renewable Energies Trail.

1. Who can book a tour?

Individuals or groups – maximum 50 people

Guided tours will be adapted to visitors' level of education.

2. Duration of the tour

2.30 hours approximately.

3. Areas to be visited during the tour

- **Visitors' Centre:** reception building where visitors will be able to enjoy exhibitions related to the energy. There is a projection hall with capacity of 200 people and a rest area inside.
- Renewable Energies Walkway: Open-air educational area equipped with renewable energies' devices.

As the Bioclimatic Houses of ITER are a touristic accommodation, the houses can only be visited under special conditions and with the assistance of the guide.

4. Guided tour programme

- Reception of visitors at the Visitors' Centre
- Introduction to ITER's main activities and R+D projects.
- Break
- Guided tour to the Renewable Energies Trail.
